HISTORY

Wooden rocking horses have been a beloved children's nursery classic for well over a century, with handcrafted examples prized for the quality of their wood carving, joinery, and finishing details. This example is carved from solid hardwood with a rich, deep cherry/mahogany-toned finish, featuring a shaped head with glass eyes and a leather bridle, a full jute or wool yarn mane and tail, a fitted leather saddle, and a traditional slatted rocker base that provides a smooth, stable rocking motion.

NOTABLE INFORMATION

- ♦ Solid hardwood body and legs, deep cherry/mahogany finish
- ♦ Glass eyes, leather bridle and saddle
- ♦ Full jute/wool yarn mane and tail
- ♦ Traditional slatted wood rocker base

COLLECTOR NOTES

Attribution note: no maker's mark is visible in the submitted photo, so this piece is valued as a well-made handcrafted hardwood rocking horse rather than attributed to a specific named maker or workshop. Quality solid-wood rocking horses with leather tack and glass eyes in this style commonly bring \$150-450 depending on condition, carving detail, and size; true antique examples (pre-1950) with documented maker history can bring significantly more. If a maker's stamp or label is later found on the underside of the rockers, this certificate can be updated with more specific attribution.
