HISTORY

Slag glass — created by swirling molten colored glass with white or opalescent glass to produce a marbled, "slag"-like appearance — was a popular decorative glass style through the early-to-mid 20th century, used widely in lamps, decorative dishes, and tableware. Napkin holders in this style were a common dining-table accessory, prized for the way the swirled glass caught light. This piece reflects the classic milk/slag glass tableware tradition, made to be both functional and decorative on a set table.

- ♦ Swirled marbled coloring characteristic of slag glass
- ♦ Functional dining-table accessory
- ♦ Condition: good, no visible chips or cracks

COLLECTOR NOTES

Slag glass tableware remains a popular niche among vintage glass collectors for its distinctive swirled coloring. Napkin holders are a more modest category than lamps or larger decorative pieces, but well-preserved, undamaged examples with strong color contrast bring the better end of the range.
