Nylena Mohair Push-Along Horse

Nylena, England — Mid-20th Century

HISTORY

Nylena was a mid-20th century English maker of push-along and ride-on plush toy animals, part of a wave of British soft-toy manufacturers producing sturdy nursery playthings in the postwar decades, alongside better-known names like Triang and Chiltern. This example features a mohair-covered horse figure with a soft, honey-toned coat, cream leg markings, and a red fabric bridle, mounted on a red-painted tubular metal push frame with four spoked wheels and a long curved steering handle designed for a toddler to push or be pulled along.

NOTABLE INFORMATION

- ♦ Mohair-covered body with cream sock/leg markings and red bridle detail
- ♦ Red-painted tubular metal push frame, four spoked wheels
- ♦ Long curved push handle, wood-block hoof supports
- ♦ Marked "Nylena, Made in England" per maker attribution

COLLECTOR NOTES

Nylena push-along horses appear periodically at UK auction houses and typically bring modest but steady collector interest, generally landing in a similar range to comparable Triang and Lines Bros mohair horse toys of the era. Condition of the mohair coat, completeness of the wheeled frame, and presence of the original bridle all factor into value — this example presents with good coat coverage and its bridle intact.

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
