DESCRIPTION

This is a substantial and finely crafted antique poured wax baby doll measuring 22 inches and notable for her considerable weight — characteristic of thick, quality poured wax construction. Her facial features are skillfully modeled with lifelike detail, and her hands and feet show careful individual finger and toe articulation consistent with higher-quality Victorian doll making. Her blue glass eyes are expressive and her open mouth and rosy cheeks give her a sweet, lifelike infant appearance. She has a traditional cloth body with poured wax head and lower limbs. No maker's mark has been identified on this doll. She is accompanied by a white wicker basket, white christening gown, lace-trimmed bonnet, and a decorative lace canopy with blue silk ribbon bow. The provenance of these accompanying accessories is unconfirmed — they may or may not be original to the doll. **Poured wax baby dolls** of this quality and size were produced primarily in England and Germany throughout the second half of the 19th century, with the finest examples coming from celebrated London workshops. The identity of the maker of this particular doll has not been established.

- ♦ Head & limbs: Poured wax — rosy cheeks — lifelike complexion
- ♦ Body: Cloth body — traditional construction
- ♦ Eyes: Blue glass eyes — open
- ♦ Mouth: Open mouth — sweetly modeled
- ♦ Detail: Finely detailed facial features, hands and feet
- ♦ Maker's mark: None identified — seller confirmed unmarked
- ♦ Accessories: Accompanied by wicker basket, christening gown, bonnet & blue silk bow canopy
- ♦ Accessory provenance: Unconfirmed — may or may not be original to the doll
- ♦ Acquired: January 2026
