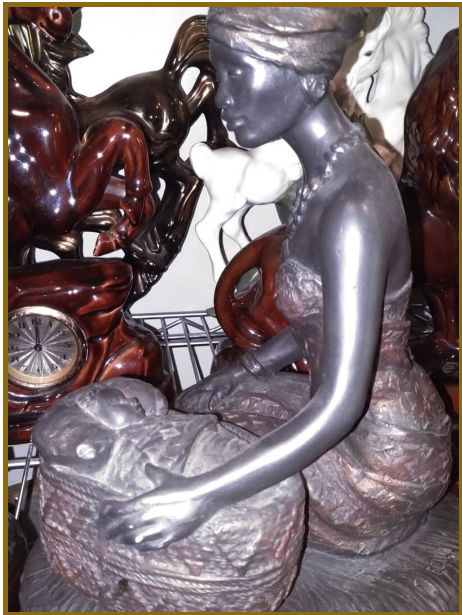

HISTORY

Figural sculptures depicting an African mother and child form a well-established decorative art tradition, ranging from museum-quality carved and cast bronze maternity figures to widely produced mid-to-late 20th century decorative statuary for the home decor market. This piece, finished in a warm metallic bronze-tone patina, depicts a standing mother figure with a child nestled at her side near a woven basket form — a composition echoing traditional African maternity imagery, which symbolically emphasizes protection, continuity, and the bond between mother and child.

NOTABLE INFORMATION

- ♦ Metallic bronze-tone finish over a resin or composite body (material not laboratory-confirmed)
- ♦ Standing mother figure with child and basket motif
- ♦ Decorative sculptural form in the African maternity figure tradition

COLLECTOR NOTES

Attribution note: no maker's mark or foundry stamp has been identified on this piece; the description here is based on visual style rather than a confirmed maker or country of origin, so this attribution is stylistic rather than verified. Decorative resin figures of this type (often sold under brands like Seymour Mann) typically bring \$40-100, while genuine cast bronze examples with confirmed African provenance can be considerably more valuable.
